There will be a camp nurse at the Health Hut from noon-4pm. If you would like to ask specific questions, feel free to stop at the Health Hut and talk with the nurse.


If you would like to see a cabin, cabin Locust is open. All of the "main camp" cabins are laid out the same on the inside.

Nature Activities

Guided Hikes – Departing from Environmental Education Center Porch.

- 2:00 pm—Archaeology Sites—Lutherlyn has been digging into the past for 19 years. Hike to three sites where archaeology is being done and see some of the artifacts that have been uncovered.
- **3:00 pm—Chapel Rock**—This 1 mile round-trip hike will take you to one of Lutherlyn's natural landmarks. Chapel Rock has been a popular destination since prehistoric times.
- Nature Activities Meet at the Environmental Education Center
- 1:00 pm—Stream Critters—Everyone loves to catch stream critters! We will provide the equipment; let's see how many things we can find!
- 1:30 pm—Searching for Amphibians— Spring is a great time to look for frogs, toads, salamanders, and tadpoles. Are you quick enough to catch some of these amazing creatures?
- 2:00 pm—Pre-School Program—A story and activity in the Discovery Room for our youngest campers.
- 2:30 pm—Terra Dei Tour Meet at Terra Dei Homestead—Learn about ways to take care of God's Creation while you explore the organic garden and the first straw bale house built in Pennsylvania.
- 2:30 pm—Edible Plants Hike—Our most camper-requested hike during summer camp involves eating your way through the forest. Try some of the wild edibles that Native Americans and pioneers would have been looking for.

The Discovery Room at the Environmental Education Center is open all day with pond critters & microscopes! Holly is at the Terra Dei Garden all day, feel free to stop by and visit or help.

Lutherlyn Equestrian Center

The Lutherlyn Equestrian Center has an Indoor Riding Arena that allows for riding lessons and programs YEAR-ROUND.

- **Noon-3:30** Equestrian Center Shuttle (departing from the Stewart Center Porch, running continuously from noon-3:30)
- Noon-3:30 Happening at the Equestrian Center:

-Pony Rides at the Lutherlyn Equestrian Center (riders must weigh less than 200 pounds)

- -Meet (and pet) our horses
- -Meet our Equestrian Center Staff
- -4-H Advanced Riding Demonstrations (In the fields around the Equestrian Center.)

Games & Activities – Noon-4:00pm

GaGa Ball – GaGa Ball is a camper favorite! The Outdoor GaGa court is near the basketball court and indoor GaGa is in the Recreation Building. Stop by either for a FUN game!

Archery – The Archery Range is in the field near Lower Lake. Archers must be 4th grade or older. No experience necessary.

Bouldering Room – Bouldering is like rock climbing except you climb horizontally instead of vertically. That means no harnesses, no heights, and no age restrictions. Give it a try in the Recreation Building!

NEW LEGO ROOM—Stop by our NEW Lego Room in the Recreation Building for some creative fun!

Cargo Net & ZipLine – The High Ropes Course and 860 foot Zipline are located in the woods near the Amphitheater. Must be 7th grade or older, less than 250 pounds, and wearing closed-toe shoes (no sandals). Everyone is welcome to watch. Due to the popularity of this activity, we have tickets available for participants with a time on them. **Pick up a ticket at the Stewart Center** and then go to the High Ropes Course at the time on your ticket. *Tickets are limited and distributed on a first-come-first-serve basis starting at 11:45 at the Stewart Center.* If you do not get a ticket you can check-in at the High Ropes Course at 3:30 to see if we are able to accommodate additional people.

Craft Cabin – Visit the Craft Cabin to make a FREE craft!

Lawn Games – Ladder Golf, Checkers, & Tic Tac Toe are located in the lawn in front of the Dining Hall. Corn Hole is on the porch of Rice Hall.

Tractor Drawn Hay Rides – Departing every half hour from the road by the picnic tables on the far side of the Dining Hall.

Indoor Corn Hole & 4-Square – The Recreation Building is a favorite "rainy day" recreation space. Stop by to play!

Canoeing & Kayaking – A lifeguard is at Brotherhood (Lower) Lake ready for you to paddle the lake in a canoe or kayak. Kayakers must be 7th grade or older. Kids younger than 4th grade must have an adult with them to go canoeing.

Make-it-Take-it Project – Visit the Woodland Quilters in the Fireside Room of the Dining Hall to make a special project.
