TIERED PRICING - Why 3 Prices? Realizing that everyone has a different ability to pay, Lutherlyn has instituted a voluntary three-tier fee program. You may choose the tier that is most suitable for your situation. It is really a free system; you tell us what is affordable for you and your family. All participants receive the same camp experience no matter what they pay! For those who cannot afford Tier I, additional financial assistance is available by contacting the camp office for a campership request form. **Tier I** is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs. **Tier II** is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the actual cost of camp. **Tier III** more closely accounts for the true cost of camp.
