All participants receive the same camp experience no matter what they pay! For those who cannot afford Tier I, additional financial assistance is available by contacting the camp office for a campership request form. **Tier I** is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs. **Tier II** is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the actual cost of camp. **Tier III** more closely accounts for the true cost of camp. This program is voluntary and in no way influences the experience anyone will receive. It offers the opportunity for families/individuals to take an active role in supporting the true cost of the camp experience at Lutherlyn!

\*Discounts & Early Bird: (Discounts & Early Bird do not apply to On-Site Day Camp or Small Fry Days.)
