Staff Alumni Challenge

After brief announcements and a few camp songs led by the 2023 Summer Staff, two members of staff from the 1990s, Becky (Albright) Franklin and Meredith (Treser) Trimble, with some assistance from Meredith's son Ian (S.I.T. '23), excitedly introduced the Building for the Future Capital Campaign.

Building for the Future will further strengthen Lutherlyn's ability to provide an environment where people of all backgrounds and ages can retreat, relax, and focus on their faith. Several projects have been planed to improve Lutherlyn's facilities and make camp more welcoming and function more effectively. Campaign projects include: renovating Steininger Memorial Amphitheater (set to begin this August), building five new cabins, removal of several unused buildings, and other site and road improvements.

In total the campaign goal is \$2.5 million, of which \$1.5 million has already been pledged! To get Lutherlyn even closer to this goal, Meredith and Becky worked with Lutherlyn's Development Office to present a staff alumni challenge and prize. A challenge goal of \$200,000 has been issued to all former Lutherlyn staff. If this goal is achieved, one of the newly constructed cabins will be dedicated

in honor of all past staff.
