

Campaign Challenge Winners: 1990s Alumni

During the All Staff Reunion in 2023, Becky (Albright) Franklin and Meredith (Treser) Trimble announced a special \$200,000 goal for their Staff Alumni peers. All gifts would benefit Lutherlyn's *Building for the Future* Capital Campaign, and, if the goal was met, one of the new cabins would be dedicated in honor of all past staff. To help encourage participation, a decade vs. decade challenge was issued, with a mini-reunion and campfire cookout on the line for the decade group who had the greatest number of participating donors and the group who pledged the greatest dollar amount.

As usual, when Lutherlyn calls, staff alumni answer! In total, Lutherlyn's Staff Alumni have pledged more than \$300,000! We are incredibly overjoyed at the results! Alumni from EVERY decade participated, but the 1990s staff pulled out all the stops and won both facets of the campaign challenge, contributing both the highest total dollar amount, in addition to having the greatest number of participants.
