Greetings from Lutherlyn! We are very excited that you selected FISHING as your major for Life in the Wild! We have an exciting week planned. There are some things that you will need to bring and be aware of for a fun and safe week for everyone!

There are some risks in fishing that are not present in other programs just due to the nature of fishing. We will be using hooks, which are sharp and can be dangerous. All campers are expected to act responsibly and follow all rules and guidelines that are presented to you throughout the week. Any camper that is perceived to be a risk to themselves or others will not be permitted to fish.

The clothing that you wear plays a big part in the safety of fishing. All campers must wear pants, close-toed shoes, a hat, a loose fitting, lightweight, long sleeve shirt, and sunglasses (or some type of eye protection) when fishing. You will be able to change into shorts and sandals when you are not fishing but it is very important that your skin is protected from flying hooks and the sun while fishing.

Please also bring a fishing pole, sunscreen, bug repellant, and a pair of old sneakers that can get wet (for wading in the lake when fishing). If you have waders feel free to bring them but there is no need to go out and buy a pair. You are also welcome to bring lures with you. We discourage treble hooks and barbed hooks are not permitted at all.
