Information

Noon-4:00 Come to the Stewart Center to collect brochures for all of the events happening at Lutherlyn. Andi, Lutherlyn's Development Director, will be available to answer questions.

Camp Tours

Tours will depart from the Dining Hall Porch at 12:30 and 2:00. Visit a cabin, the Environmental Education Center, Health Hut (with a camp nurse ready to answer questions), Store, Dining Hall, Pool, Craft Cabin, and Recreation Building.

There will be a camp nurse at the Health Hut from noon-4pm. If you would like to ask specific questions; feel free to stop at the Health Hut and talk with the nurse.

If you would like to see a cabin, Locust and Yellow Pine are open. All of the "main camp" cabins are laid out the same on the inside. Locust and Yellow Pine are circled on the map on the back of this booklet.

Bathrooms

Bathrooms are located at the Dining Hall (both sides), Environmental Education Center, in the stand-alone building in front of the Environmental Education Center, and outside of Baker Chapel. There is a porta-potty at the Lake and the Equestrian Center.

Nature Activities

Nature Activities – Meet at the Environmental Education Center

1:00 PM – Stream Critters: Everyone loves to catch stream critters! We will provide the equipment – let's see how many things we can find!

1:30 PM – Edible and Medicinal Plants: Our most camper-requested hike during summer camp involves eating your way through the forest. Try some of the wild edibles that Native Americans and pioneers would have been looking for.

2:00 PM – Survival Skills: Learn some of the essentials for surviving in the forest alone – including being prepared, building a shelter, and starting a fire.

2:30 PM – Chapel Rock Hike: This 1-mile round-trip hike will take you to one of Lutherlyn's natural landmarks, a very *gneiss* rock outcropping that you won't want to take for *granite*!

3:00 PM – Miller Lake Hike and Tour: Hike around Miller Lake, visiting our marsh wetland and archaeology site.

The **Discovery Room** at the Environmental Education Center is open all day! Please supervise children and follow the posted guidelines.

Lutherlyn Equestrian Center

You are invited to visit the Lutherlyn Equestrian Center today. To control traffic and parking, please sign up for a time block at the Stewart Center. 20 vehicles/half hour can sign up to drive to the Equestrian Center. Directions and parking instructions will be given when you sign up for your time block. If it is raining, please DO NOT have an open umbrella near the horses.

Noon-3:30pm Pony Rides (riders must weigh less than 200 lbs), meet (and pet) our horses, meet our Equestrian Center Staff.

Games & Activities – Noon-4:00pm

GaGa Ball – GaGa Ball is a camper favorite! Indoor GaGa is in the Recreation Building. Outdoor GaGa is near the Jump Pillow. Stop by for a FUN game!

Archery – The Archery Range is in the field near Lower Lake. Archers must be 4th grade or older. No experience necessary.

Cargo Net & Zipline – The High Ropes Course and Zipline are located in the woods near the Amphitheater. Must be 7th grade or older, less than 250 pounds, and wearing closed-toe shoes (no sandals). Everyone is welcome to watch. Due to the popularity of this activity, we have tickets available for participants with a time on them. **Pick up a ticket at the Stewart Center (parent/guardian/adult signature required on waiver for minors)**, and then go to the High Ropes Course at the time on your ticket. ***Tickets are limited and distributed on a first-come-first-serve basis starting at 11:45 at the Stewart Center.***

Craft Cabin – Visit the Craft Cabin to make a Friendship Bracelet or a flower craft!

Tractor Drawn Wagon Rides – Departing every half hour from the road by the picnic tables next to the Dining Hall.

Bouldering Room – Bouldering is like rock climbing except you climb horizontally instead of vertically. That means no harnesses, no heights, and no age restrictions. Give it a try in the Recreation Building!

LEGO Room—Stop by the Lego Room in the Recreation Building for some creative fun!

Indoor Corn Hole & 4-Square – The Recreation Building is a favorite “rainy day” recreation space. Stop by to play!

Creativity Lab – The Creativity Lab (in the Recreation Building) is a space to craft and create whatever you want with the supplies provided.

Canoeing & Kayaking – A lifeguard is at Lower Lake for you to paddle the lake in a canoe or kayak. Kayakers must be 7th grade or older. Kids younger than 4th grade must have an adult with them for canoeing.

S'Mores – What's a visit to camp without roasting a marshmallow or making a S'more? Fire circle next to Dining Hall. (Rice Hall if raining.)

Games & Activities – Noon-4:00pm

Jump Pillow – Jumpers must wear socks. No shoes on the jump pillow. The jump pillow guidelines are posted on the fence.

Lawn Games – Ladder Golf, Checkers, & Tic Tac Toe in the lawn in front of the Dining Hall. Corn Hole and shuffleboard are near the shelter next to the jump pillow.

Make-it-Take-it Project – Visit the Woodland Quilters in the Fireside Room of the Dining Hall to make a special project. They will also have some craft items and quilt raffle tickets for sale.

Prayer Path – The prayer path is located along the road across from the path to Chapel Hill. Pick up a Prayer Path map in the Stewart Center.

Hiking – Lutherlyn has 17 miles of hiking trails. If you would like to hike the trails today, pick up a trail map in the Stewart Center or join one of the guided hikes led by our Environmental Education staff.

Scavenger Hunt – Pick up a scavenger hunt from the Stewart Center and bring your completed scavenger hunt back for a prize.

Fishing – Come to Upper Lake to cast your line and try your hand at fishing. All fishing at Lutherlyn is catch & release. **NOON-2PM ONLY**

Closing Campfire – We will gather together next to the Dining Hall at 4:10 for a closing campfire. Please join us to sing some camp favorites!
