The clothing you wear plays a big part in the safety of fishing. All campers must wear close-toed shoes and a wide brim hat or a baseball hat with the brim facing forward when fishing. You will be able to change into sandals when you are not fishing.

Please bring a fishing pole (rod and reel), sunscreen, bug repellent, and a pair of old sneakers that can get wet. We will provide hooks, lures, and bait. If you do not have a fishing pole, please e-mail leep@lutherlyn.com so we can prepare one for you to borrow for the week.
