Camp Life. Campers live in cabins with bunk beds and full bathrooms (including showers). Counselors live with their cabin group and campers are never left unsupervised. Cabin groups eat, play, learn, and live together as a family. There are opportunities each day for campers to explore their own interests and get to know others in the camp community.

Week-long programs are Sunday afternoon (2:30-4pm check-in) until Friday evening (families are invited for 6:30pm worship & 8pm departure).



The Lutherlyn staff are specially trained (including First Aid & CPR) to ensure a safe, meaningful, and enjoyable experience!

A registered nurse and lifeguards are on site all summer long to provide for the health and safety of each camper.



How do I sign-up?

Register online or print a registration form at www.lutherlyn.com/summer. Call the office if you would like a paper registration form sent to you. Shortly after you register, you will receive an e-mail with further details. **It is important for the registration process that all payments and forms are completed in your online account at least 2 weeks prior to the start of camp.**

Cancellation Policy. The \$100 deposit is refundable until June 1st. After June 1st the \$100 deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. The balance is due two weeks before coming to camp. Camp fees are not refundable or transferable for cancellations made within two weeks of the scheduled session except for medical reasons. The fee for campers leaving camp for medical reasons or family emergencies may be refunded on a pro-rated basis.

What am I paying for? The fee includes all programming, three healthy meals and a snack each day, lodging, and highly trained staff. The only additional expense is a store account to purchase snacks, drinks, and Lutherlyn merchandise at the camp store and crafts in the Craft Cabin. Rocketry campers have the option of purchasing additional rockets. Campers may give an offering from their store account to the annual ministry project.

Tiered Pricing - Why 3 Prices? Realizing that everyone has a different ability to pay, Lutherlyn has instituted a voluntary three-tier fee structure. Choose the tier that is most suitable for your situation. **Tier I** is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating camp programs. **Tier II** is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the actual cost of camp. **Tier III** more closely accounts for the true cost of camp.

Classic Camp—Together with your camp friends you can swim, do crafts, enjoy evening campfire, conquer group challenge activities, play games, discover nature, canoe, hike, play outside, just be yourself, and have the time of your life!

Juniors (Grades 4-6) Weeks 2, 4, 5, 6, 7

Jr. High (Grades 7-9) Weeks 2, 4, 5, 6, 7

Classic Senior High—Take all that you love about Classic Camp and add late-night social time, movies, specialty crafts, adventures, and service opportunities.

Grades 10-12 Week 4

Classic Sampler 1/2 Week—Classic Sampler is a taste of Classic Juniors for first time campers who want to start their “camp career” with a 1/2 week. ****1st time campers only.****

Juniors (Grades 4-6) Week 5A (July 12-15) & 5B (July 15-17)

Young Folks Short Week—A half-week camp experience with all of the excitement and activities of a full Classic Camp week for 2nd and 3rd graders!

Grades 2 & 3 Week 2A (June 21-24), 5A (July 12-15), & 5B (July 15-17)

Level 1 Adventurers—Explore outdoor adventures! Stay in a cabin at camp (one overnight in a tent at Moraine State Park) and be ready for a new adventure every day! Each day will feature a half-day excursion off-site where you will enjoy rock climbing, canoeing, hiking, and the high ropes course at camp. Moderate level of physical activity. **MAXIMUM 10 CAMPERS PER WEEK.**

Jr. High & Sr. High (Grades 7-12) Weeks 1, 2, 5, 6

Level 2 Adventurers—For campers who have done the Level 1 program. Spend half of the week tenting at Ohiopyle State Park. The other half of the week stay at Lutherlyn. Rock climbing, rappelling, white water rafting, caving. High level of physical activity. **MAXIMUM 10 CAMPERS PER WEEK.**

Jr. High & Sr. High (Grades 7-12) Weeks 3, 4, 7

Junior On-Site Adventurers—Junior Adventurers are invited to a rustic week at camp. Try out the climbing wall, high ropes course, canoeing, Lutherlyn's longer hiking trails, and spend a night or two sleeping in a tent (along with all of your favorite Classic Camp activities). **Juniors (Grades 4-6) Week 7**

Arts & Musical Theater Camp—Choose your form of artistic expression. Each day, receive 2-3 hours of instruction in your chosen art form. The rest of the day will be spent doing Classic Camp activities. **NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY.**

- **Arts & Crafts**—painting, drawing, crafts
- **Guitar**—for the musically curious
- **Pottery**—slab projects, hand building, give the wheel a try
- **Musical Theater**—Enjoy the thrill of rehearsing an original musical and preparing for a live production on Friday evening!

Sr. High Musical Theater Day Camp—Monday-Friday, 9am-3pm at Lutherlyn for rehearsal (lunch included) and then a performance at 4pm on Friday for family and friends. No experience necessary, just the desire to sing and perform!

Life in the Wild—Choose your major for your morning adventures. The afternoon will be spent doing exciting camp activities.

- **Archery**—Try your hand at specialty targets and games with a bow and arrow.
- **Survival Skills**—Build shelters and camp fires, purify water, and eat plants!
- **Fishing**—Learn fishing skills. Try different kinds of bait. Try to catch Big Louis!
- **Animal Encounters**—Catch crayfish and other aquatic critters, scout for animal tracks, and capture salamanders and other amphibians!
- **Archaeology**—Dig into the past, literally, with Lutherlyn's archaeologist.

Juniors & Jr. High (Grades 4-9) Week 1

Model Rocketry—Spend your week building model rockets, launching your rockets in a variety of competitions, and develop a fun hobby! Refine your skills and let your imagination soar. Light Saber optional. Each camper has a \$25 credit for rockets. Additional rockets can be purchased with a store account.

Juniors (Grades 4-6) Week 7 Jr. High & Sr. High (Grades 7-12) Week 6

Camp Medley—Do a different specialty activity each morning: tie-dye, canoeing, archaeology, high ropes course, outdoor living skills, and be a "Night Owl" for a night! The rest of your day will be spent doing your Classic Camp favorites.

Jr. High (Grades 7-9) Weeks 1, 6

Night Owl Club—Lively nocturnal adventures! Stay up late—even all night. Go on night-sound & star hikes. Play night games. Eat breakfast for a midnight snack. Experience worship with glow sticks. Watch the sunrise and THEN go to bed!

Jr. High & Sr. High (Grades 7-12) Week 7

Venture—Join us for theme nights, morning cartoons, hanging out with friends, staying up late, and LOTS OF SURPRISES just for Senior High Campers!

Sr. High (Grades 10-12) Week 6

Horse Camp—Enjoy a fantastic week of learning about horses, improving your skills, and riding in a beautiful setting! Instruction is offered for riders of all abilities by certified instructors. All horse campers spend their “non-horse” time doing lots of great Classic Camp activities! MAXIMUM 8 CAMPERS PER WEEK.
