Dining:

Meals are served buffet style at designated meal times in our Dining Hall. Our chef can accommodate dietary needs as necessary. Please include information regarding your needs when registering (food allergies, gluten free, vegetarian, etc.) so we may plan appropriately for your stay.

Accommodations:

The housing options for Family Camp are "main camp" Cabins (Arbor, A-Frame, Log Cabin, and Ridge Villages), Shaulis Cabins, Campsite with Electric, and Tent Site. Meals and program are included with each housing type.

Cabin assignments will be made through a lottery drawing to be held in May. In order to be part of the drawing Lutherlyn must have your registration and your housing request by May 1st.

"Main camp" cabins are equipped with central heating, carpeting, and full bathroom facilities (shower, toilet, and sink). Each family-style cabin features 6 twin beds (4 bottom bunks and two top bunks).

Shaulis Cabins are more rustic and can house 10 people (5 bottom bunks and 5 top bunks). Each has a bathroom and shower.

Campsites include electricity, but do not have a water or sewage hook-up.

All guests are responsible to bring their own linens and toiletries. Please note that for the safety and welfare of all guests Lutherlyn has a NO PETS and NO ALCOHOL policy.

Pricing is based on the number of guests, and their ages, and is available at lutherlyn.com/familycamp. A \$100 deposit is required at the time of registration. The balance is due two weeks before your arrival for Family Camp. Many families pay their balance in installments (monthly, bi-weekly, whatever works for you!).
